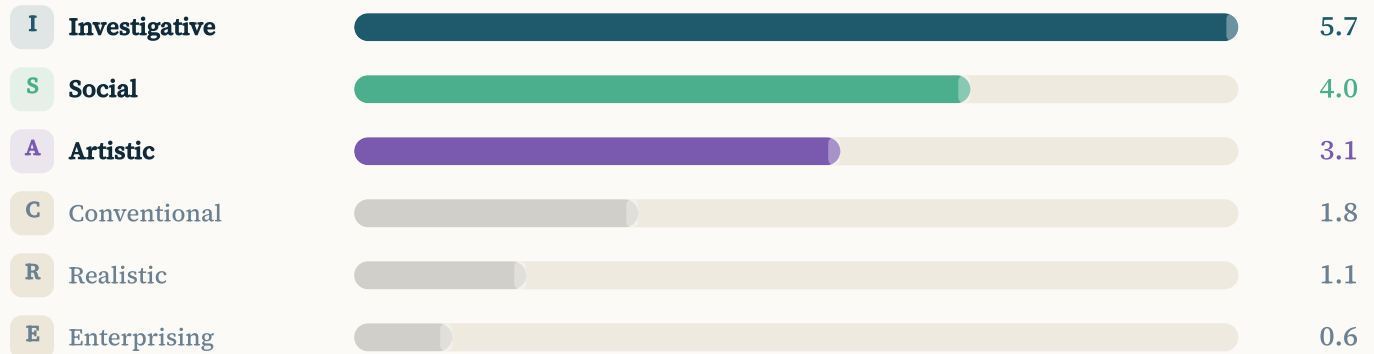

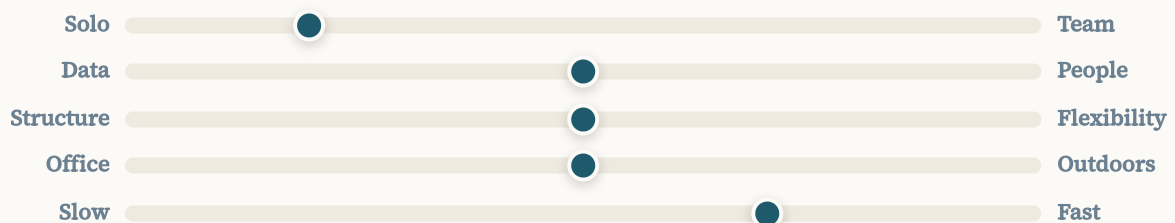

THIS WEEK

Find one person from your top direction and ask 3 questions: what their ordinary day looks like, what they enjoy and what annoys them, how they got there.

THIS MONTH

IN 3 MONTHS

Ask yourself honestly: are you still in this direction? What was confirmed, what wasn't? Adjust course based on facts.

6-12 MONTH HORIZON

- if your profile sharpened — rebuild the choice. That's not failure, it's calibration.

AI-ERA SKILLS

AI is a tool, not a competitor. For the adult professional three skills matter: framing the task for the model, checking its answers against reality, and integrating it into your work so it saves hours — without delegating meaning.

WHERE TO START — THIS WEEK

- take a task you do regularly and do it with AI — compare it to your old way;
- learn to frame the request: what I want, in what form, with what context, an example of a good result;
- always double-check facts, numbers and links — the model is confidently wrong;
- use AI as a thinking partner, not a replacement: let it generate options — you decide.

This isn't "for programmers" — it's basic literacy in any profession.
